The purpose of this research to know whether there is any positive and significant effect Movie Subtitle with vocabulary Mastery in Senior High School 1 Punggur academic year 2021/2022. This research is quantitative research conducted at the tenth grade of Senior High School 1 Punggur that involves of 32 students as the samples. This research was using two types of variable, variable independent and dependent. Independent variable is Movie Subtitle and dependent variable is vocabulary mastery. The technique sampling used Random sampling technique.

The research instruments used in this study were multiple choice. To determine the effect of using movie subtitle in learning. Researchers used pre-test and post-test questions to conduct research. The pre-test questions were given before the research and the post-test questions were given after doing the research.

The data of this research was analyzed by using pre-test and post-test result. the data confirmed that "tobserved"= 3,839 was higher than "ttable" level level of significant 5% = 0,300 and level of significant 1% = 0,186. therefore, it can be concluded that H_a is accepted and H_o rejected. It means There is a positive and significant the effect of "using Movie Subtitle on the students vocabulary mastery of the tenth grade of Senior High School 1 Punggur".

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CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

A. The Background of the Study

Language has a very important role in human life, which is used as a means of communication. It allows us to communicate with information about something we need. We know English is one of the most important foreign languages. The function of language is so important for human life. That is the reason why scientific research is at the center of human interest. Students must have four language skills such as listening, speaking, reading and writing. There is also a language components, vocabulary, spelling, and structure.

In Indonesia, English is a foreign language. In our education system, it is a compulsory subject from Junior High School to College. As a foreign language, this English is not easy to master because it has a different structure, pronunciation, etc. In addition, the purpose of teaching and learning foreign languages is that students can communicate in spoken and written form. besides, vocabulary is one aspect of language that must be learned by students who want to master a language. Vocabulary can help students to have good listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills. One of the reasons arises from these failures students still find many difficulties to express their ideas in English. This is caused by a situation where students pay less attention to vocabulary mastery.

One of the important things to master a language is vocabulary. Without good vocabulary mastery students cannot master a language well. Students who have sufficient vocabulary will have no difficulty understanding the meaning of a word, so they can find out the meaning of the text easily. And to get meaning and read text easily, students need to know the structure, pronunciation and vocabulary. Generally, students are lazy to memorize it, because the vocabulary is very large. Besides, they lack the motivation to learn English. So, they have difficulty understanding and remembering the meaning of vocabulary. And they think that English is one of the most difficult subjects.

Therefore, to improve students' vocabulary mastery, good media are needed to support students in the learning process. This is because the media is an instrument to improve the quality of learning. Its aim is to make learning English fun and easy for students in learning situations. In addition, it also makes students feel bored in class by providing good media, where the media will be directed to motivate them to increase their desire to learn vocabulary.

Media is one of the tools to facilitate the delivery of learning by teachers to students. A movie produced for entertainment that tells the story and what people watch on the screen or television. Movie subtitles translate dialogue into text right up to the screen. movie is a good medium for the learning process. The use of movie in teaching and learning is very

important to provoke reflective processes and attitudes in students. Audiovisual method refers to sound and images which are usually in the form of slides or videos and recorded speech or music; all visual presentations shown by the teacher to the students. The audio visual method in this study uses English subtitles.

The use of movie can be important in teaching and learning and also underlines that active learning can be better encouraged and supported through the usage of audio-visual materials from the popular culture arena. Where movie in class can support students in the learning process, especially vocabulary, there are other results which state that English movie have a positive role in motivating students to learn English vocabulary.

Using subtitles can play a key role in foreign language classes, to help overcome this problem and can be used to improve word recognition and vocabulary skills in EFL classes. Subtitles in the form of subtitles can also help students keep track of speeches that might otherwise be lost. The addition of subtitles in the movie can also help students, if they do not understand the context properly, they can immediately see the movie that has been provided or the existing subtitles on the LCD screen / computer and from the movie they can also take pictures. the content of the dialogue directly in the film.

It turns out that the use of movie subtitles media can provide instant feedback and positive reinforcement which helps create self-confidence in students which can help them feel ready and motivated to watch foreign movie and subtitles support movie in the near future.

The advantage of this movie is that it can accommodate through reading the subtitles. Reading is one of the most important skills for student's success in school and in life. Reading is an active, successful process at school and in life. Reading is an active process, because it involves the interaction between the reader and the text. This means that researcher integrate vocabulary with reading.

Based on the data above, the researcher can find out how high the students' ability to master English vocabulary. From the research that has been done, there are only 8 students who have fulfilled the material mastery criteria and there are some students who have not fulfilled the material mastery criteria. The researcher conducted research on the 32 remaining and used material mastery criteria, namely 70. Based on these data the researcher have conducted a study entitled The Effect of Using Movie Subtitle as Media on the Students Vocabulary Mastery of the tenth grade of Senior High School 1

Punggur. In this study, the researcher chose the title and in class X Senior High School 1 Punggur, because the researcher want to know Is there any positive and significant effect Movie Subtitle with vocabulary Mastery in Senior High School 1 Punggur.

B. Problem Identification

Referring to the background of the problem it can be identified as follows:

1. The students had lack of vocabulary mastery.
2. Students difficult to master vocabulary.
3. Media still less to support in English learning process.

C. Problem Limitation

Based on the problem identification above, the researcher focuses on the problem where the students had lack of vocabulary mastery. So the researcher limits the problem on using movie subtitle to increase the students' vocabulary mastery at the tenth grade of Senior High School 1 Punggur.

Is there any positive and significant effect Movie Subtitle with vocabulary Mastery in Senior High School 1 Punggur academic year 2021/2022?

The purpose of the study, is to determine Whether there is any positive and significant effect Movie Subtitle with vocabulary Mastery in Senior High School 1 Punggur academic year 2021/2022.

G. Prior Research

The researcher found several previous research can be analyzed. In this study the authors took part of the research to consider the research to be studied:

The first research conducted by Husnul Lail This study aims to determine¹ in the form of descriptive text understanding in class VIII students of SMPN 1 Selong, East Lombok in the 2018/2019 academic year. The resulting learning out in this study includes learning outcomes in the form of cognitive skills and vocabulary mastery. This research is a quasi-experimental research. The population was all classes VIISMPN1Selong. Sampling was done by random sampling technique for the population in the unit class. The research sample was class VIIIA as the control class using conventional learning (lectures) and VIIIB as the experimental class using film media with subtitles. The data were obtained through a pre-test to determine students' abilities. The statistical test used to test the hypothesis is the Mann Whitney U test with the normal Z curve approach carried out on the post-test data.

The Second research conducted by Nadhifan Dzulfahmi, Alfu Nikmah which This investigation was aimed to identify² One of the main challenges in teaching English is finding the right method and materials that are engaging, interesting, and up to date while at the same time helps the students learn. This is not only boring, but also ineffective in helping the students to retain the vocabulary because it does not provide context on how the vocabulary can be used. Movies have the potential to be used to provide an interesting and engaging vocabulary learning experience. To test the vocabulary mastery level of the students, before the movie starts they were given a list of vocabularies.

They are instructed to write down the meaning of words that they know while leaving the ones they don't know empty. Then, they are told to pay attention to the vocabulary used in the movie and try to memorize their meaning with the help of the subtitle.

The third research conducted by Seyed Jalal Abdolmanafi, Rokni Azam Jannati Atae This investigation was aimed to identify³ Oral Performance Proficiency Test At the beginning of the study to determine the language proficiency of the learners, they were given an Oxford Placement Test. The test was assumed to test the learners' proficiency in English. Speaking Test The speaking test consisted of 10 questions. In order to conduct this research, in order to measure the level of listening comprehension of the subjects, they were administered the pretest. Next, as treatment an original authentic movies was shown to both groups. After the treatment, the posttest was given to two groups (Bimodal and No subtitle) to judge whether or their listening comprehension improved.

CHAPTER II

THEORETICAL REVIEW

A. Vocabulary

1. The Concept of Vocabulary Mastery

Vocabulary is an important element in language learning because it helps students to express their feelings and opinions well. According to Elfrieda, vocabulary is knowledge of the meaning of words.¹ Students who have a lot of vocabulary easily understand the material taught by the teacher accurately and effectively.²

Vocabulary is a collection of words that have meaning, it is impossible in the process of teaching and learning English without mastery of vocabulary, from learning the language of a foreign language means learning its vocabulary. This shows that people will do nothing in communication if they do not know the words or vocabulary of the language. Vocabulary is very important for them during learning.³ So, vocabulary mastery can help students have good speaking, reading, listening and writing skills.

According to Hornby, vocabulary is a number of words (with rules for combining them) that make up a language.⁴ This seems to indicate that vocabulary is fundamental for learners who wish to speak or produce any utterance. By mastering vocabulary, students can use language to express their feelings.

Vocabulary is best learned when one feels that a certain word is needed.⁵ Based on the above concept, vocabulary mastery is important for learners in learning a language. Without mastery of vocabulary, students cannot communicate well. They cannot understand any teaching from what they hear or read. As we know that it is impossible to learn a language without vocabulary. That is, without vocabulary, learners cannot achieve their goals in learning language as a means of communication.

Hornby defines mastery as complete knowledge or complete skill. Mastery means complete knowledge or great skills that make a person master certain subjects.⁶ Mastery is related to understanding the ability to use the knowledge or skills possessed. This means that mastery is one's understanding or one's ability by using the knowledge or skills possessed by students. Vocabulary mastery is an actualization for someone who wants to learn to read, speak and write in English. All of these activities really require vocabulary mastery. Apart from hands-on grades,

vocabulary mastery is important for their future profession. Along with the increasing role of English as an international language, mastery of written languages other than spoken languages is indeed a determining factor. This implies that mastery of vocabulary is a must because it is difficult, if not impossible, to write or speak without speaking have and know a number of words.⁷ Without mastering vocabulary, it is not possible because the learner can achieve the goal. Vocabulary is the part of words that are familiar in the language, usually growing and as a basic tool for communication.

Based on the definitions explained above, so it can be concluded that vocabulary is part of learning to determine the extent of the vocabulary of the new language. From there, vocabulary Mastery is very important for everyday life. because in mastering English vocabulary, it is a second language used by other people to communicate. In other words, vocabulary is the key for students to be able to understand other people speaking with the large number of vocabulary that can make it easier for students to know lessons such as speaking, listening, reading and etc.

2. The Kinds of Vocabulary

Hatch and Brown said that , the vocabulary is divided into two, including:

- a. Receptive Vocabulary is easy for students to understand and recognize, but it is not often used by people to communicate and write.

- b. Productive vocabulary is Some of the vocabulary words that can be used for writing and speaking that are often used by a person⁸. This vocabulary is also included in the vocabulary that is often used in everyday life.
- c. Print vocabulary, the vocabulary consists of words whose meanings are already known when we are writing or reading silently. We can conclude that the vocabulary that we are writing or reading is oral and printed are divided according to the way students receive words.

Nation explained that the vocabulary consists of two kinds namely, receptive and productive vocabulary. Receptive vocabulary that can involve or perceive the shape of a word when listening or reading and taking its meaning from the word. Activities like this collect vocabulary rather passively. Productive vocabulary involves the desire to express meaning through speaking or writing and taking and can produce form words that are spoken or written appropriately⁹. Besides requiring active performance, it also stimulates students' confidence in expressing their ideas, opinions and thoughts in speaking.

Nation said that there are four types of vocabulary in text:

- a. High frequency words. These words make up almost 80% of the words that run in a text that is read. For example: function words (in, for, from, a), content words (government, forest, production).

- b. Academic words. Usually, these words make up about 9% of the words running in the text; that means it can contain many common words in various types of academic texts such as policy, phase, adjustment, and sustainability.
- c. Technical words. These words make up about 5% of the words running in the text; it contains several words that are very closely related to the topic¹⁰. In this case the topic is planting forests, so the technical words are adat, regeneration, podocarp, beech.
- d. Low frequency words. These are medium frequency words that did not make it to the high frequency list.

3. Vocabulary Knowledge

Vocabulary knowledge is an important learning to know the number of osakata in a second language. Because it has a small vocabulary, it can make it difficult to learn a second language to communicate¹¹. From this vocabulary knowledge has a great influence on the learning system . As such it is not directly in the ability to solve a problem that occurs when the meaning of a language is lost in a vocabulary. Vocabulary knowledge can be said to be successful if a student can understand the meaning of words and can practice directly to someone by communicating properly and correctly, then from there vocabulary understanding can go according to the student's goal of

memorize vocabulary. Thus students can directly show the progress obtained during vocabulary learning.

If students can have more new vocabulary they know, it can help students to communicate and increase their confidence to express the ideas they think about. But if students do not have vocabulary, students will experience obstacles to understand text and speech¹². Students are expected to understand parts of the utterances that will be spoken such as nouns, verbs, pronouns, etc. as their knowledge for communication. It can be said that vocabulary knowledge is an important factor in their learning process. This means that without knowing the vocabulary, students cannot express their ideas and will face several obstacles in developing four English skills.

4. Definition of Vocabulary Mastery

Mastery of vocabulary has always been an important part of the English language. According to Thomas, mastery is a term used by all educators and is believed to be well understood by them. While Mosher in Thomas states that mastery is only reaching a certain level of understanding of certain content, while competence represents the ability to apply what has been mastered.

One of the components to mastering English as a foreign language is vocabulary mastery. This means that students have the ability to understand and use words and meanings. It also plays an important role in

English language skills.

Vocabulary plays a very important role in learning a second or foreign language. Vocabulary is considered an important part of mastering a second language. As quoted by Virginia F. Allen that to master a language by learning, learners must also know and understand the meaning of words.

Furthermore, Ying He said that vocabulary is knowledge of words including explanations of word meanings. To master a word is not only to learn its meaning but also to learn its register, association, collocation, grammatical behavior, written form, spoken form and frequency¹³ how the words work together in sentence.

The vocabulary test which will be utilized to measure the learners' vocabulary mastery is dealing with the measurement of productive skills that is the vocabulary knowledge required for writing.¹⁴ The measurement of vocabulary mastery is Multiple choice (choose the correct answer) tests are questions or assignments whose answers are chosen from more than two alternatives. Most of the alternative answers ranged between four and five. Example:

B. The Concept of Movie Subtitles

1. The definition of movie subtitles

Movies are a comfortable familiar medium to contemporary students that can keep student's interest in the theories and concepts under discussion. Although most movies are fiction, they can offer powerful experiences that students are unlikely to have in a classroom.¹⁵ Investigated the effects of subtitled TV programs on the listening comprehension of beginner, intermediate and advanced learners of English. Use two subtitled videos on topics not known to the learners. Each group viewed both movies with and without subtitle. Measuring the participants' comprehension by some multiple choice questions, he found that all three groups using the subtitles performed significantly better.¹⁶

Subtitles are the written translation of film dialogues appearing synchronously with the corresponding dialogues produced on the screen.

That the process of subtitling involves 3 steps:

- a. from one 'language' to another
- b. from verbal speech to a written text
- c. from a non-condensed (verbatim) to a condensed (non-verbatim) form of text.

Subtitles are translated texts usually displayed below the image, as on a cinema or television screen, subtitles are most often displayed above the stage, in live opera and theatre performances. The aim of subtitles is to convey the meaning of what is being sung, not necessarily the manner in which it is being sung. Interjections such as 'Oh!', 'Ah!' or 'Ye Gods!', and musical repetitions of words and phrases, need not be included. Flowery or poetic turns of phrase may be simplified. Punctuation can be kept simple or omitted, in particular exclamation marks; we can see the singers 'emoting' on stage, so the titles do not have to do it for us.

Suggest that subtitled movies encourage learners to consciously notice new vocabulary and idioms, and as such, may have potential to facilitate vocabulary acquisition without being a distraction for learners.

2. Type of subtitles

There are different types of subtitles in English. They are standard subtitles (foreign language audio with mother tongue captions),

bimodal subtitles (foreign language audio with foreign language subtitles), and reversed subtitles (mother tongue audio with foreign captions).¹⁷

The main ones are typically known as:

- a. Standard subtitles (foreign language audio with mother tongue captions)
- b. Bimodal subtitles (foreign language audio with foreign language subtitles),
- c. Reversed subtitles (mother tongue audio with foreign captions).

The most commonly used combination is the standard one, also called interlinguas. The bimodal variety, also called intralinguas, is also commonly used in classroom activities; the use of one or another in class will depend on the goal of the lesson and on the students' Level.

3. The Advantages and Disadvantages of using movie subtitle

by watching movies those with English subtitles get more easy to get the meaning of the movie lion language. With visual media equipped with English subtitles can facilitate the level of understanding students in listening to their English. Animated movies with subtitles in England can be a medium that they don't realize that they are learn English. This means that their focus other than reading subtitles they also listen how say the text that is in the subtitle it is spoken by speech narrator (actor and actress) in the film. Subtitle with English as the target language in the film that pushed them in other skills, such as vocabulary, listen and read.¹⁸

a. Advantages of Using Movie Subtitle

The advantages of using movie in teaching and learning process are:²⁰

- 1) Students can mastering vocabulary easily, by studying while watching movies that will make students not bored.
- 2) Students can arrange vocabulary in the Movie Subtitle.
- 3) Students can listen using English vocabulary and can know the meaning of what is heard and read.
- 4) Students can listen to the vocabulary in the movie subtitle.
- 5) Each student can learn something from the movie, from the clever ones to the less intelligent.

C. Theoretical Framework and Paradigm

1. Theoretical Framework

There are two variable in this research. They are independent variable (X) and dependent variable (Y). The independent variable is movie subtitle and the dependent variable is vocabulary mastery.

This is the reason every level of education provides English lessons to students. Movie are one of the techniques for teaching student. Especially now that an increasingly up to date and modern era, many student use their gadgets, computer or television for learning, for example student can use movie to learn English. Because movie subtitle can make it easier for students to learn English without getting bored quickly.

To teach English using movie subtitles, the teacher must know how to choose a movie that suitable the learning material. This means that the teacher can convey the material using the subtitle movie. Based on the

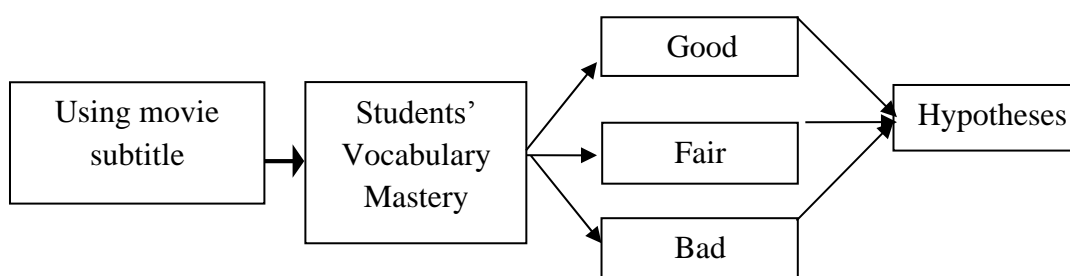

value of vocabulary mastery is average, the value of vocabulary mastery is moderate. Finally, if the level of vocabulary mastery is low, the students' vocabulary mastery ability is low.

D. Hypothesis

- a. Alternative hypothesis (H_a) : There is a positive and significant influence of the “ Using Movie Subtitle on the Students’ Vocabulary Mastery at The Tenth Graders of Senior High School 1 Punggur in the Academic Year of 2020/2021.”
- b. Null Hypothesis (H_o) : There is no positive and significant influence of the “Using Movie Subtitle on the Students’ Vocabulary Mastery at The Tenth Graders of Senior High School 1 Punggur in the Academic Year of 2020/2021.”

2. Statistical Hypothesis

Statistical Hypothesis is an assumption about a population parameter. Related to this research the Statistical Hypothesis is:

If $F_o > F_t$, H_a is accepted and H_o is rejected.

If $F_o < F_t$, H_a is rejected and H_o is accepted.

CHAPTER III

RESEARCH METODOLOGY

A. Research Design

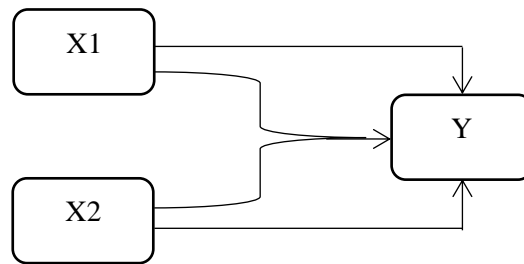
This research has been done at Senior High School 1 Punggur. In this study, researcher have investigated the tenth class students who have 9 classes consisting of 32 students / class. The research was conducted in November 2021. This research use quantitative methods Researcher apply a study using a sample. The researcher created to determine the effect of using movie subtitle on the students' vocabulary mastery. Quantitative research is research that collects a lot of data, from collecting data, interpreting data, to presenting data.

The independent variable is a type of explanatory variable that can be presume to be the cause of the variation of other explanatory variable. While the dependent variable is the explanatory variable which is thought to be influence by the independent variable.¹ In short, the independent variable is influenced and the dependent variable is the variable that gives effect to the dependent variable. This study will treat the use of learning strategies (X1) and (X2) movie subtitle on vocabulary mastery (Y), to determine whether or not there is a positive and significant effect of using X1 and X2 learning strategies on students' vocabulary mastery (Y).

B. Population, Sample, and Sampling Technique

1. Population

The population is all members of the research subject who have similar characteristics. The number of members of the population is very large to infinity and can also be "relatively" not many, can be counted in number and cannot or are mutually counted, can be identified entirely and can only be partially recognized.

Because the population has these characteristics which do not allow researchers to take all members of the population, including consideration of effectiveness and efficiency, research can "only" be

carried out on some members of the population.² In this study what is mean by the population is the entire subject of the study, namely students of Senior High School 1 Punggur tenth grade totaling 315 students from X IPA 1-5 and X IPS 1-4.

2. Sample

The population is large and does not allow the researcher to determine the sample in that population, for example due to lack of funds to conduct research using a large population, there is also the researcher's energy and time to conduct research, so the researcher can use a sample that will be taken from a large number of people to conduct research. In order for the results of the study to be generalizable to the population, the samples taken must be representative. That is the sample must reflect and be representative of the state of the population. The requirements for representativeness of a sample are determined by several things, and the main thing is the taking of sample members randomly and the number of members that is sufficient so that it can be tolerated. from the above statement the author used a sample class X IPS 3 as a research sample consisting of 32 students from 315 students.

3. Sample Technique

The sampling technique is influenced by the needs and objectives of the study. To find out the sample that will be used to research this research, the researcher use the sampling technique for his research.

C. The Operational Definition of Variables

There are two variables in this research, while the operational of variables as follows:

1. Independent Variable

This variable can be interpreted as the cause or effect of the dependent variable. For example, when researcher in the field of education study the effects of various teaching methods, researcher can manipulate methods as (their independent variables) by using various method³. This study use the movie subtitle to vocabulary mastery. This study will use movie with title “Akeelah And The Bee” this movie is very suitable for high school students to watch. Because this movie uses narrative speaker, it feels more real and we can also learn pronunciation and context. This movie is also very educational, there are many moral messages that we can take from this movie. There are several indicators showing that students can master the objectives of this movie as follows:

- a. Students can mastering vocabulary easily, by studying while watching movies that will make students not bored.
- b. Students can add vocabulary in the Movie Subtitle.

2. Dependent Variable

The dependent variable is also called the output variable, criterion, consequent. The dependent variable is not manipulate, but this variation will be observed as a result of a prediction, which comes from an independent variable use. Usually the dependent variable is a condition in which we want to describe the variable or we describe it in the study. The dependent variable of this study is English mastering vocabulary. This means that mastering English vocabulary is a skill to improve other skills, because in speaking, writing and reading we need good vocabulary mastery.

D. Data Collection Method

1. Test

Researcher used a vocabulary test as an instrument to collect data. The test material is taken from the subject matter taught to students. Therefore, this study uses the test method in data collection to measure these two variables. In the data collocation using test multiple choice. The students will answer multiple choice questions about the vocabulary that has been obtained from learning using the movie subtitle.

Furthermore, the researcher used a test to collect data consisting of pre-test and post-test as a data collection method to measure the results

of mastery of English vocabulary. Researcher measured teaching through with pre-test and post-test :

- a) A pre-test is has been given to students at the first meeting for know students' abilities in advance before using movie subtitle in their vocabulary mastery. The type of pre test is multiple choice, total number of test items are twenty. The items were based on the material that was taught in the class.
- b) A post-test is has been given at last meeting after treatment to find out if the statement give whatever contribution to vocabulary mastery is then experimental class is higher than the previous class or is there a positive and significant difference between the experimental class and the previous classscore. This step has been done after the treatment to know the effect of using movie subtitle as media on the student's vocabulary mastery at the tenth grade of senior high school 1 punggur.

2. Documentation

Document analysis is a method of data collection which involves analysis of content from written documents in order to make certain deductions based on the study parameters. The method is mainly used in qualitative research as a method of qualitative analysis. Documentation is a note which has already passed, can be shaped writing, (diaries, stories, regulations, policies), documents in the form of pictures (photographs, vivid images, sketch). In the research, researchers will collect documents. In this study, researcher use data from school documentation such as the

number of students, teachers, school history and school conditions at Senior High School 1 Punggur in the Academic Year of 2021/2022.

E. Research Instrument

1. Instrument Blueprint

To obtain data that are interrelated with the research problem, the researcher used a written test instrument in this study.

2. Instrument Calibration

The instrument use in the vocabulary test is a A pre-test was administered before the study to identify the extent of the students' vocabulary mastery. Post-test will be given after doing research, to

identify the increase in the students' vocabulary mastery level. Resarcher uses the concept of a multiple-choice test instrument technique consisting of four cached answer choices (A, B, C, and D). The material that will be tested previously is vocabulary. The author uses 20 items for the pre-test and 20 items for the post-test.

F. Data Analysis Technique

This study researcher use a simple statistical formula to compare the results pre-test and post-test of students who conduct the survey. The data will be analyzed using the t-test formula to determine the significant effect and treatment and use the Chi-Square to be able to find out positive and significant things after doing the research. The formula illustrated as follows⁴:

CHAPTER 1V

A. Research Result

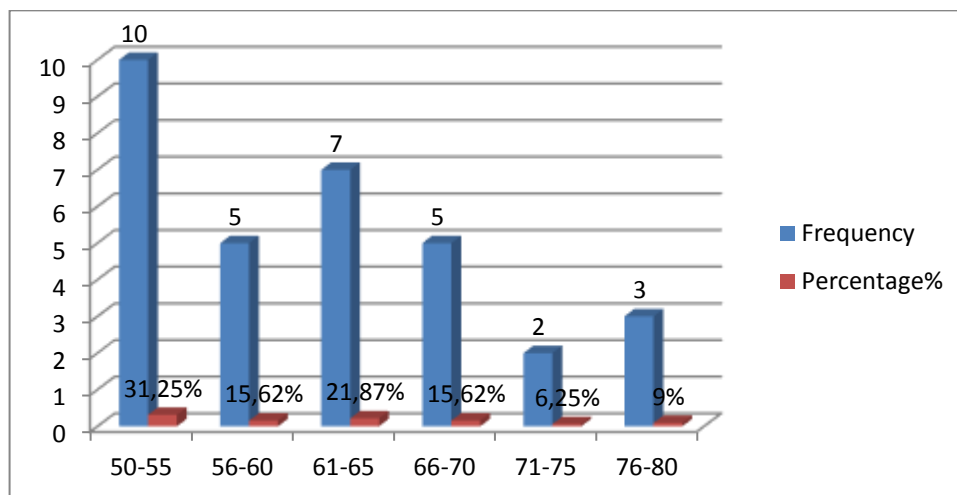

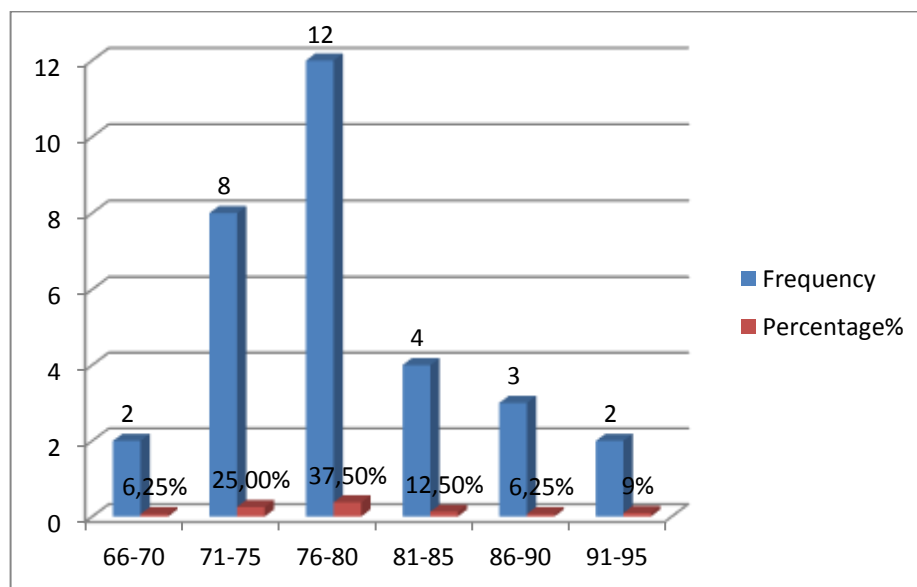

Ho : There is no positive and significant effect of using movie subtitle as media on the student vocabulary mastery at the tenth grade senior high school 1 punggur.

Statistical Hypothesis

If $F_{\text{observed}} > F_{\text{table}}$, Ha is accepted Ho is rejected.

If $F_{\text{observed}} < F_{\text{table}}$, Ha is rejected and Ho is accepted.

Based on the analysis of the data above, it is known that the value of $F_o > F_t$ is $0.300 < 3.839 > 0.186$, then Ha is accepted and Ho is rejected, this meaning that there is a positive and significant effect on the use of movie subtitles as media on the student vocabulary mastery at the tenth grade of senior high school 1 punggur.

C. Discussion

In this research, there are two variables, the independent variables is Movie Subtitle (X), and dependent variables is Vocabulary Mastery (Y). The variables were tested by using formula of Chi-square and T-test to investigate whether there is a positive and significant effect of using Movie Subtitle on the Students' Vocabulary Mastery of the tenth grade of senior high school 1 Punggur. Before the research, the resercher gave pre-test in order to find out

the Students' level on Vocabulary Mastery before treatment. The results indicate that the highest score was 80 and the lowest score was 50 with the average was 63,28. After finishing the treatment, the researcher gave post-test. The result showed that the highest score was 95 and the lowest score was 65 with the average was 80.

During the research, the researcher saw that the students were happy in the learning process and found that the students knew more vocabulary in the Movie Subtitle And student able to master vocabulary through Movie Subtitle easily. After the reseacher provides a learning technique using the Movie Subtitle to master English vocabulary, there is a significant difference in the effect of students' vocabulary mastery results, especially for class tenth of senior high school 1 Punggur. In fact, it shows that the students' scores change.

D. Limitation

This research was conducted at the Tenth Grade of senior high school 1 Punggur in the academic year 2021/2022 class X IPS 3. About the effect of using Movie Subtitle on the Students' Vocabulary Mastery. So, the result was limited only to this class and this rescarch can not be generalized. If this research was doing in different place, students, academic year possibility the result of the resultof the research will be different also.

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusion

The purpose of this research to know whether there is any positive and significant effect Movie Subtitle with vocabulary Mastery in Senior High School 1 Punggur academic year 2021/2022. This research is quantitative research conducted at the tenth grade of Senior High School 1 Punggur that involves of 32 students as the samples. This research was using two types of variable, variable independent and dependent. Independent variable is Movie Subtitle and dependent variable is vocabulary mastery. The technique sampling used Random sampling technique.

The research instruments used in this study were multiple choice. To determine the effect of using movie subtitle in learning. Researchers used pre-test and post-test questions to conduct research. The pre-test questions were given before the research and the pre-test questions were given after doing the research.

The data of this research was analyzed by using pre-test and post-test result. the data confirmed that “tobserved”= 3,839 was higher than “ttable“ level level of significant 5% = 0,300 and level of significant 1% = 0,186. therefore, it can be concluded that Ha is accepted and Ho rejected. It means There is a positive and significant the effect of “using Movie Subtitle on the students vocabulary mastery of the tenth grade of Senior High School 1 Punggur”.

B. Sugestion

1. For Students

Students are not too bored in learning using the Movie Subtitle, because they can learn and watch. Students become more confident in mastering English vocabulary. So, they can learn vocabulary. And students can improve in learning.

2. For Teacher

Teachers can use learning media in mastering English vocabulary. By using learning media can make learning more active and not bored in learning.

3. For the Principal

The principal can support the English learning process by preparing complete facilities and instruments. That way students can more easily master the vocabulary.

4. For Other Researchers

Other researchers should focus on other aspects of English teaching and learning process. Further researchers can estimate the implementation of watching movies and other variables with the media and learning materials.


