Learning Result are things that can be seen from two sides, from the side of students and from the side of the teacher. Learning outcomes are expected to be achieved, it is necessary to plan and a good teaching program, besides that it is necessary to pay attention to the factors that influence it. The factors that influence the learning outcomes achieved by a person are the result of the interaction of various factors that influence it both within (internally) and from outside (externally) the individual. The question in this research is "Is there any influence between Economic Background on the learning outcomes of 11th grade students of SMK Muhammadiyah 1 Metro?" The purpose of this study was to determine how much influence the Economic Background had on the learning outcomes of 11Th graders students of SMK Muhammadiyah 1 Metro.

This type of research is quantitative data. Data collection techniques in this study are questionnaires and documentation. The questionnaire method in this study is the main method that the author uses to determine the economic background of students' parents. While the documentation method in this study was used to obtain information and data such as school profiles, school history at SMK Muhammadiyah 1 Metro and student data at SMK Muhammadiyah 1 Metro. The data analysis technique that the author uses is statistical analysis. The formula that will be used to analyze the data in this research is the Product Moment formula.

After the data is analyzed, it is known that the data analysis that has been carried out using the product moment formula is obtained with the r-count value when compared to the r-table, which is larger, namely r-count = 0.796, which is greater than the r-table, which increases at a significant level of 5% 1% means that the hypothesis that the author proposes in this research reads that there is a strong/high relationship between Parental Economic Background and Learning Outcomes of English Subjects for 11th grade students of SMK Muhammadiyah 1 Metro 2021/2022.

INTRODUCTION

A. Background Of Study

English education is very important for students where growth and developments in modern times like this require guidance in the use of English. This is in accordance with Chapter II Article 3 of Law No.20 of 2003 concerning the National Education System, which states that: National education functions to develop capabilities and shape the character and civilization of a dignified nation in the context of educating the nation's life, aiming at developing the potential of students to become human beings who believe and fear God Almighty, have noble character, are healthy, knowledgeable, capable, creative, independent, and beco¹.

The Goal of National Education must be pursued through an education and teaching process whose implementation really thinks about the development of students so that what is sought and the goals desired by teachers in imparting knowledge to students will be able to achieve the desired goals.

The economic background of parents seems to have an influence on students access to learning. Parents are expected to provide economic facilities

They must not only learn rapidly in order to get by in their everyday lives, but they must also adapt to life in a school setting where their native language is not spoken. Different behavioral and academic norms, new social customs, and different cultural values are only afew of the obstacles. Factors that contribute to the porosity and learning outcomes are external conditions and internal conditions of students³.

Parents who have the ability a good economic will meet the needs learning their children like meeting their needs of textbooks and facilities others that support children's learning. The economic background of good parents will able to influence learning facilities at home student. Therefore, it is necessary to use the economic ability of parents well so that learning facilities at students' homes can be well fulfilled so that this will improve student learning outcomes.

The Parents economic background ability is a factor that comes from outside the individual. Parents are expected to provide economic capacity to his son. If the economic capacity of parents is getting better, it will have an

As an individual he must meet all the needs for survival. As a social being, he is required to adapt to life together. Through parents, children learn to help each other, get to know customs, both at home and abroad family and community environment. Thus the family environment is very important for development child. Where parents must pay attention to all the needs of children. Parent must provide adequate living,know the development of children and good interaction. As stated by the sociologist below.

The economic situation is adequate, so parents can full fill everything needs of their children. Like in trouble education, health, and so on. Thus the children too feel that all the abilities they have are channel and well. This is because availability of tools for their development. Apart from that, good communication between parents and children will affect their development or achievement.

All humans need education as a provision in the future. Will but the current cost of education is very high. Therefore, parents are responsible for the development of their children. But on the fact that many parents pay less attention to the problems of their children. For example: in education, children have good academic potential. But parents do not provide tools that can

channel their potential. For example, textbooks, stationery, bags, shoes, school uniforms, and so forth. Due to economic factors or parental income very low. So that children cannot develop their skills. That, because educational needs are not available to children, low school achievement.

From the problems that arise in the world of education, namely the parents follow economic backgroundto learning result is low. And parents High income means high child outcome. But this is not an absolute outcome. Therefore, children who have parents who earn enough him fact get high learning result.

From the problems that arise in the world of education, namely parents from social low economic, the child's learning result is low. And high-income parents then the child's outcome is high. However, research has shown that this is not always the case. Previously, it was assumed that children from low-income households performed better than children from high-income families.

Based on a pre-survey that the author has conducted on September 15, 2021 through the interview with the English subject teacher, namely Mr.Dono Amsaroh, S. Pd. he said, most of the 11Th Accounting students of SMK Muhammadiyah 1 Metro have sufficient learning outcomes, and the economic background conditions of the parents of the students, the majority of which are in the middle income group, are between Rp. 1,500,000 - Rp. 2. 500,000 per month. Because the economic background parents of these students are mostly low-income so that the learning tools owned by students are limited, for example, the textbooks used by students to study are only textbooks at school.

The Economic Background situation of the family has a role in the development of children, for example a family that is economically sufficient, causes the material environment faced by the child in his family to be wider, so that he gets wider opportunities to introduce various kinds of skills, which these skills cannot developed if there are no tools.

Parents of SMK Muhammadiyah 1 Metro students consist of various kinds of parents from different economic backgrounds. These different economic backgrounds can also affect the ability of parents to finance their children in the procurement of learning facilities and infrastructure, which will make it easier for schools to improve the teaching and learning process. A set of learning requires a lot of money, learning tools are textbooks, notebooks, pencils, erasers and others so that the condition of parents is one of the factors that affect learning outcomes.

This is in accordance with the statement submitted by the Deputy Head of Students Affairs at SMK Muhammadiyah 1 Metro, Mrs. Yeniarti, S.Pd who said that the economic background conditions of parents in the 11th graders Accounting at SMK Muhammadiyah 1 Metro were different, there were middle-lower economic conditions and the economic conditions of their parents were middle-upper. This is because each parent has a different job, there are parents whose jobs are farmers, traders, laborers and there are also some parents whose jobs as employees are never civil. However, the parents who found them at SMK Muhammadiyah 1 Metro were farmers. From this

income, parents fulfill their family's needs, for example for food, shelter, and sending their children to school.

The following are Supporting Data (10 Students) on learning outcomes and the economy of parents. However, this is not the population that the authors use in this study, the authors choose class XI Accounting 2 because the majority of students get results that exceed the Minimum Completeness Criteria, for the KKM English subject at SMK Muhammadiyah 1 Metro, which is 75.

CHAPTER II

THEORETICAL REVIEW

A. The Definition of English Learning Results

1. Definition English Learning Results

Learning outcomes are statements of the knowledge, skills and abilities individual students should possess and can demonstrate upon completion of a learning experience or sequence of learning experiences, Learning outcomes should be specific and well defined. When developing a list of student learning outcomes, it is important that statements be specific and well defined. Outcomes should explain in clear and concise terms the specific skills students should be able to demonstrate, produce, and know as a result of the program's curriculum. They should also exclude the greatest number of possible alternatives so that they can be measured.¹

Based on the opinion above, it can be explained that the learning outcomes that have been achieved after receiving a knowledge that is embodied in the form of values or numbers, so the results of the students' efforts in these activities are obtained a change in the form of mastery of knowledge, attitudes and skills that will be between the same students. with others. The intended knowledge and skills are students' learning

efforts that appear in changes in behavior as a result of the learning process.

Based on the description above, it can be obtained that the learning outcomes obtained by students in receiving knowledge or insight in a learning activity that includes affective, cognitive, psychomotor aspects. Learning outcomes are very dependent on the past learning process by students, in this case today's students can be separated from the role of the teacher during the teaching and learning process. After carrying out learning activities, it is expected that the maximum results achieved, a change in behavior in students is one of the achievement of big goals.

3. Factors That Affect Learning Results

Teachers and parents influence various parts of a student's life, and therefore, success is attributable to different factors. Parents have an important role in terms of motivation and educational expectations, as well as socio-economic status. However, it is teachers who create positive

teacher-student relationships in classrooms that are culturally inclusive, collaborate with other mainstream educators, and differentiate instruction and assessment to meet student needs. Ultimately, in order for English Language Learners to have academic success, it is important that parents, teachers, and students work together to create an optimum learning environment and opportunities for student achievement.

According to (Hanus, 2016) In terms of inspiring their children to learn and want to develop their language skills and proficiency, parents play a critical role. Although both extrinsic and intrinsic motivation are essential for a child's success, parental motivation is a distinct type of motivation that has a more direct and positive impact on student achievement. Children are more likely to be inspired to achieve these goals if their parents make it clear that education is necessary and that language skills and proficiency are needed. Parents' perceptions of their children's talents and capabilities have a direct impact on their motivation and self-perceptions of what they are capable of academically. Age is also an important factor that affect learning a new foreign language Snow⁴.

Hoefnagel-Hohle (1978) conducted a study monitoring the progress of students who were newly-resident in the Netherlands and had begun learning Dutch. A few months after arrival, older students outperformed the younger students in the development of the new language. However, within about a

year, younger students were able to surpass the level of performance of the older students. This suggested that further research was needed to identify the factors that might mediate the effects of age in the process of language acquisition⁵.

(Rintaningrum, Aldous and Keeves, 2017) Motivation, whether intrinsic or extrinsic, plays an important role in language learning. If a student enjoys learning the language or does well in this subject, he or she will continue to excel. Furthermore, if the language is required to achieve a specific goal (acceptance to a preferred university, a specific career goal, communication with family, etc.), students will put forth greater effort to learn the language and, as a result, will make faster progress. Experience can also be a major factor in Learning English Any student who has lived in other countries and/or has been exposed to travel, diverse cultures, and languages has a stronger base for learning. Students who might have a pen pal, opportunities to Skype or interface with native speakers, and those who have English-speaking friends will learn more easily⁶.

This means that humans have an economic life that requires meeting basicneeds both as individuals and as members of society. It is a quadratic for humansfrom birth to have a problem in the economic field that surrounds their life processbecause economic problems are a matter of how one can maintain their survival sothat it can be said that economic problems cannot be separated from human life⁷.

C. The Parental Economic Background Correlation To Student Learning Results



CHAPTER III

RESEARCH METHOD

A. Research Design

This study uses Quantitative Research methodswith correlation type. Because in this study, after the necessary data were collected, the data were analysed using quantitative or statistical data. Ahmad Dahlan No. 1 Metro, and since August 17, 1997 SMEA Muhammadiyah 1 Metro changed its name to SMK Muhammadiyah 1 Metro, as well as relocated to the Muhammadiyah IV complex which has a new building on a 5600m² land located on Jl. Tawes 21 PolosYosodadi Metro Timur Metro City.





Based on the table above, it can be seen that the results of the calculation of "r" product moment obtained a value of 0.796, when consulted with the table "r" product moment is in the range of 0.600 - 0.800, in this case there is a strong or high correlation or relationship. so that between the variable X (Economic Background) and the variable Y (English Learning Result) there is a strong or high relationship.

D. Discussion

The relationship of each variable (Independent Variable With Dependent Variable) the results of data analysis through the above calculations are consulted in the table of correlation coefficient values r table at significant level 5%.

Based on the results of data analysis obtained rxy of 0.796 and df = n-nr = 34 - 2 = 32. By checking the table of "r" product moment values, it turns out that with a df of 32 at a significant level of 5%, an r_{table} of 0.349 is obtained while a significant level of 1 % obtained r_{table} of 0.449. so that the results in this calculation can be concluded that there is a strong or high relationship between economic background about the results subject english learning at 11th graders of SMK Muhammadiyah 1 Metro.

Based on the test results, it turns out that *rxy* or "*r*" count is greater than "*r*" table, both at a significant level of 5% and a significant level of 1%, so that the hypothesis that the author proposes is accepted, which means there is a relationship between variable X (Economic background) and Variable Y (English Learning Result) students of SMK Muhammadiyah 1 Metro.

Furthermore, when viewed from the interpretation table (r) of the product moment, the magnitude of rxy or r count is 0.796 at a level between 0.600 - 0.800, which means that there is a strong correlation between X and Y variables. The results of the research that the author did explain that The Correlation Between Economic Background and English Learning Result of 11th Graders at SMK Muhammadiyah 1 Metro.

The existence of The Correlation Between Economic Background and English Learning Result of 11th Graders at SMK Muhammadiyah 1 Metro is evidenced by the results of data calculations using the product moment formula, after calculating and showing the results that the research that the author did has a high or strong relationship.

E. Research Limitations

This research has strived to conform to procedures and produce robust or accurate results. but it can be explained that there are still many shortcomings in this study. Therefore, this research still has some limitations and weaknesses, including:

- Due to the large number of students at SMK Muhammadiyah 1 Metro, only class 11 is taken with a total of 185 with a sample of 34 students from each major.
- The results of this study only apply in 11th graders of Muhammadiyah 1Metro Vocational High School.

BAB V

CONCLUSIONAND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusion

Based on the results of the data analysis that the author did, in this case the author can conclude that there is a significant correlation Between Economic Background and English Learning Result of the 11th Graders of SMK Muhammadiyah 1 Metro.

This is proven by the results of the calculated correlation with a correlation of 0.796 greater than the table, both at a significant level of 5% the price is 0.349 and a significant level of 1% is obtained at a price of 0.499%. so that the hypothesis that the author accepts is accepted, which means there is a The Correlation Between Economic Background and English Learning Result at 11th Graders of SMK Muhammadiyah 1 Metro.

These Results show that having a good economic background will help improve English learning outcomes Result at 11th graders of SMK Muhammadiyah 1 Metro.

B. Suggestion

If in this study the author can provide advice to all parties involved in the education and teaching process in schools, especially at SMK Muhammadiyah 1 Metro.


1. To parents, even though the economc is low, they must provide motivation or support so that children learning outcomes remain good.


